If these statements resonate with you, then keep reading!

We don't need a performer – what we need is a *leader*. The person joining our team will minister from the overflow of their own personal worship. In other words: if you're spending time with Jesus, it will show!

So, *who* are we looking for? You should...

- Be **gifted** – *leading* worship isn't the same as “singing up front.”
- Be **organized** – you'll need to have a steady, consistent schedule for a team that is relying on you.
- Be **nice** – nobody wants to work with a jerk!

Now, *what* do we expect you to do? You will be...

1. Modeling and leading heartfelt worship in an invitational style – that draws people in, encourages participation, and points people to Jesus.
2. Planning our weekly Sunday 10:00am worship service. The worship songs should engage the congregation and support the sermon series in a relevant way.
3. Recruiting, auditioning, teaching, and training musicians in (and out!) of the church to serve the congregation as a team with musical skill and humility.
4. Leading weekly rehearsals that serve a dual purpose: **(A)** preparation for Sunday and **(B)** cultivation of Christ-centered community.
5. Serving as a member of the ministry team at Family Community Church, demonstrating a commitment to this congregation and its mission.

What you'll want to know: This is a **part-time** position requiring 10 hours/week. The hours are pretty fluid and will include Sunday mornings.

To our amazing church family:

Yesterday, I made an exciting announcement to our church family: with the unanimous vote of our Local Board of Administration, we will be rebranding our church with a new identity. Effective Sunday, September 6th, we will officially relaunch as **Family Community Church!**

This process began with a simple question: *as a church, who are we?* I have wrestled to answer this for many months, combing extensively through the rich history and deep-rooted legacy this church once held. First and foremost, we are – and will *continue* to be – a Wesleyan church. This is a heritage to be proud of! However, WWC was once a thriving house of ministry, reaching many families in our community. In more recent years, the church has struggled simply to exist, and a painful truth became evident: we had to change our approach, or we would continue to deteriorate.

To drive our ministry efficacy – which we measure by the number of lives that are transformed by the Gospel of Christ and the hope of a future with purpose – we have developed a new mission and vision, based on biblical values and driven by the Gospel.

Our mission is clear: “**Growing God’s Kingdom Through Our Community.**” This encapsulates the biblical mandate for both evangelism and discipleship (Matthew 28:18-20, Ephesians 4:11-16). We need to help win new souls to Christ, and the community of Warrenton is ripe for the harvest!

How will we see this mission accomplished? Our vision explains this in greater detail:

“We will build a **family-centered** culture of discipleship and authentic Christian community where we **Embrace, Encourage, Equip, and Empower** families with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the hope of a future with purpose.”

- **Embrace** people at every stage of life and maturity, no matter where they are
- **Encourage** spiritual growth through Gospel-centered preaching and teaching
- **Equip** our church family to engage in active ministry in their respective circles of influence
- **Empower** our church family by fostering ministry opportunities and releasing people for service

Sarah and I are thrilled to be part of this amazing community, and we look forward to many years of fruitful ministry here in Warrenton. As we build God’s house, we will do so together – as all families should. I am so blessed to be your pastor, and there is nowhere else I would rather be.
